

Unbroken Chain Reaction from Origin




Law of Causality (Objection)

#### Self-Existent Universe

Universe did not have a beginning. Universe always existed.





Law of Non-Contradiction

An object cannot be in two contradictory or opposing states at the same time within the same context.



Law of Non-Contradiction

For the universe to come from nothing the universe would have to exist, before it existed, in order to create itself.



Law of Non-Contradiction

Either/Or Logic

Something is either true OR false at a given time.

Both/And Logic

Something can be true AND false at the same time.
