PROCESS

Begins with the original language

PURPOSE
Transcribed for various audiences




3 Main Approaches to Translation:

WORD-FOR-WORD

THOUGHT-FOR-THOUGHT

PARAPHRASE





WORD-FOR-WORD:

- LITERAL seeks to match the original language's words and phrasing.
- Example: New American Standard (NASB, ESV)
- Useful for precise study.



THOUGHT-FOR-THOUGHT:

- Dynamic Equivalent upholds the true meaning & concepts of the original language.
- Example: New International Version (NIV, NLT)
- Useful for general reading, study & memorization.



PARAPHRASE:

- Free uses current words and phrasing to convey the ideas found in the original language.
- Example: The Message (MSG)
- Useful for getting "the big picture" or main ideas.



JOHN 2:15-16 (ESV)


¹⁵ And making a whip of cords, he drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and oxen. And he poured out the coins of the money-changers and overturned their tables. ¹⁶ And he told those who sold the pigeons, "Take these things away; do not make my Father's house a house of trade."

JOHN 2:15-16 (NIV)

So he made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple courts, both sheep and cattle; he scattered the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables. To those who sold doves he said, "Get these out of here! Stop turning my Father's house into a market!"

JOHN 2:15-16 (MSG)

Jesus put together a whip out of strips of leather and chased them out of the Temple, stampeding the sheep and cattle, upending the tables of the loan sharks, spilling coins left and right. He told the dove merchants, "Get your things out of here! Stop turning my Father's house into a shopping mall!"



What is the best translation for you to use?

Readability...Make sure you are comfortable with the Bible you choose to read. Can you understand it without constant use of references?

Accuracy...Find a balance between accuracy and readability.
