

(Beginning of the Universe)


"In the beginning (TIME)





(Implausibility of Infinite Past)




(Implausibility of Infinite Past)

# (P2) Universe Came from Something

(Law of Non-Contradiction)

Nothing cannot transition into something because nothing is non-existent and is therefore devoid of any formative power to create itself.
